Nacpan Beach, the most known beach in all of Palawan and maybe the Philippines, this 4km stretch of beach is the kind of place you'd see if you closed your eyes and imagined paradise. This beach-style glamping will be your home for the next two nights and trust me it will have you not wanting to leave! Check-in and grab some dinner at the neighboring resort then have a relaxing night, you deserve it.

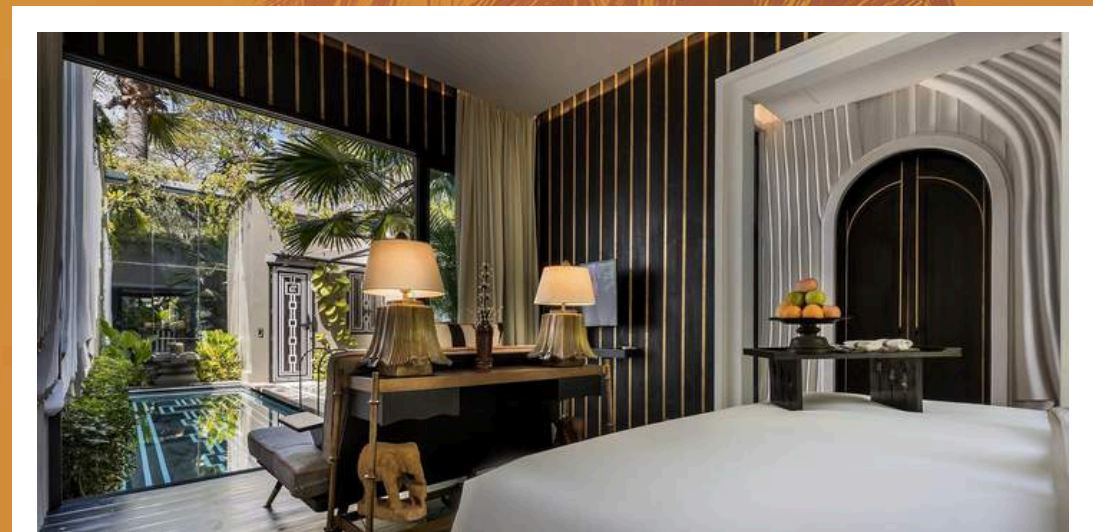

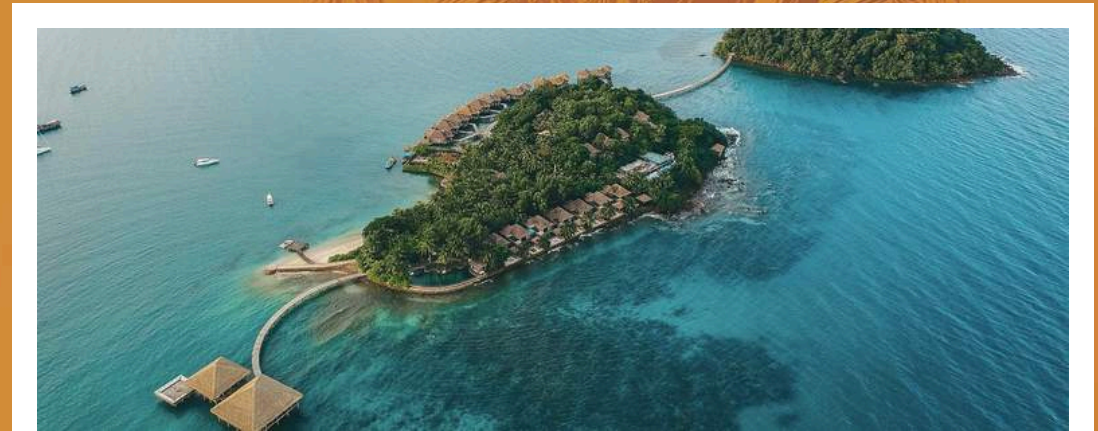

By 6:00 am, we'll arrive at the mystical Srah Srong, or "King's Bath." Witness the magnificent spectacle of the sun casting its golden light upon the ancient temples, their reflections shimmering on the still water. Savor a delicious breakfast after the mesmerizing sunrise. Nestled in a beautiful Khmer house, enjoy a complimentary glass of champagne upon arrival, followed by a free flow of soft drinks, chilled juices, Angkor Beer, tea, and coffee.

Next, venture into the heart of the jungle to explore the captivating Ta Prohm temple. Be among the first visitors to witness its majesty bathed in the soft morning light. As the jungle awakens, immerse yourself in the tranquility and listen to the symphony of nature. Our adventure continues with a visit to the grand Preah Khan temple. Explore this vast complex, a maze of vaulted corridors adorned with intricate carvings and moss-covered stonework. Be transported back in time as you delve into its rich history.

### DAY 3 | SIEM REAP – ANGKOR WAT & BANTEAY SREI TEMPLE [B/L/-]

This morning visit Angkor Wat. Angkor Wat is one of mankind's greatest achievements, and the intricate carvings at the temple of Angkor Wat demonstrate the skill of the Khmer builders. It was constructed in the jungle in the early 12th century, then - two centuries later - was mysteriously abandoned by the Khmer civilization. Now Angkor Wat is the main reason tourists come to visit Cambodia.

After Angkor Wat continued to visit Banteay Srei temple, loosely translated as "Citadel of Women." It is home to some of the finest and best-preserved examples of classical Khmer bas-relief. The walls are densely covered with some of the most exquisite and intricate carvings of any Angkorian temple. The temple's relatively small size, pink sandstone construction, and ornate design give it a fairyland ambience.

On the way back to town, you will visit the Roluos Group of temples, built in the 9th century and the capital of the Khmer Empire under King Jayavarman II. You will visit Bakong Temple, a massive stepped pyramid that is considered to be the prototype for Angkor Wat.

Late afternoon return to Siem Reap to spend the afternoon relaxing by pool.

This is one of the best places in all of Cambodia where objects embodying the brilliance of the Khmer civilization can still be viewed; continue to visit the National Museum with its huge collection of Khmer sculpture and artifacts recovered from Angkor. After lunch, make a trip to visit the Toul Sleng Prison, housed in a high school, to glimpse the devastating horrors that prevailed during Cambodia's ultra-radical Marxist movement. This excursion may prove distressing for some; it is however an important piece of Cambodia's recent past. After, take an excursion to Choeng Ek, also known as the "killing fields,"- located just outside the city. Afterward, return to your hotel to spend the evening free at your leisure. We recommend visiting Phnom Penh's charming riverside which is buzzing with activity and has many good restaurants.

## DAY 13 | PHNOM PENH - SUNSET BOAT CRUISE [B/-/-]

This morning is your free time, explore bustling markets, pamper yourself with a luxurious spa session, or sink into a blissful massage - your relaxation itinerary awaits!

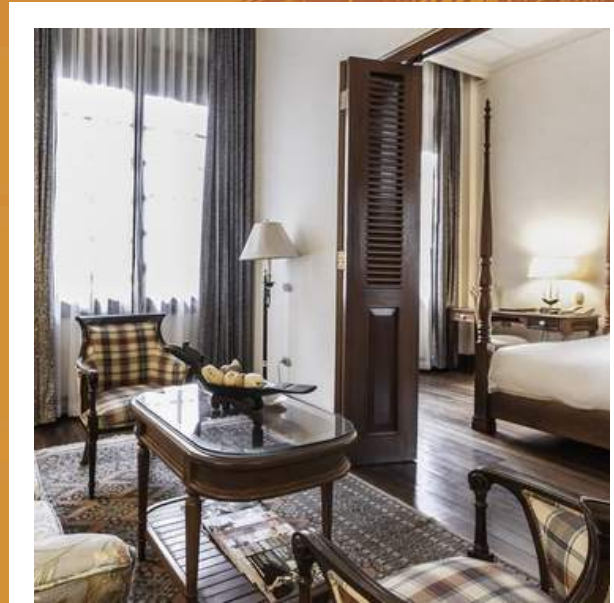

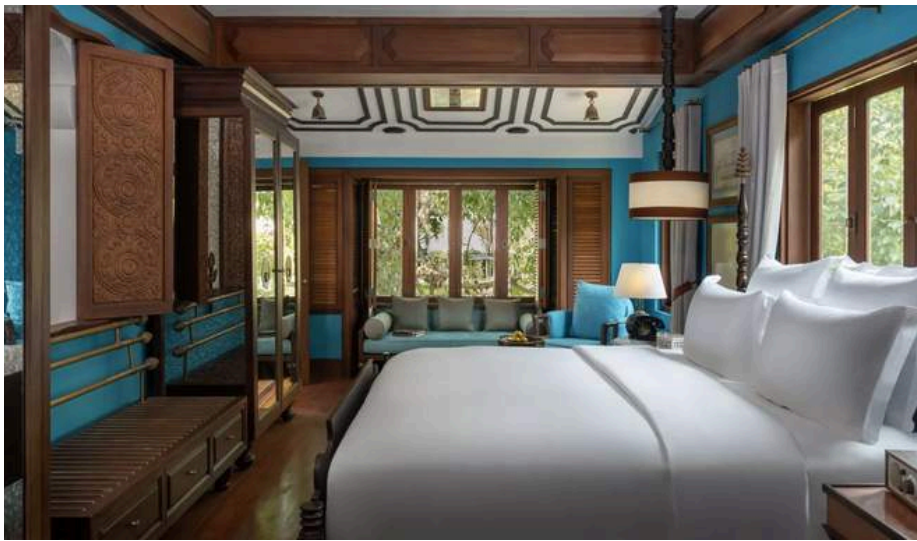

## DAY 1 | LUANG PRABANG – ARRIVAL [-/-/D]

Sabaidee! Welcome to Laos. After clearing customs and collecting your bags, you will get transferred from the airport to your hotel for check in. Spend some time to freshen up after the journey.

The day is free at leisure until 6PM. Before dinner, you will get a short Orientation Session to discuss the exciting journey ahead. Then a Welcome Dinner will be arranged! Tonight we have your first Lao meal. Following dinner, you have the option to visit the famous night market, where you can find a lovely selection of handmade textiles made by local and hill tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang.

Luang Prabang, a quiet UNESCO Heritage Site considered by many as the center of Lao culture. Nestled in a mountain valley at the confluence of the Mekong and Khan rivers, the city offers a fascinating glimpse into the Buddhist religious practices and traditional lifestyles of hill-tribe groups in the northern region of Laos.

## DAY 2 | LUANG PRABANG - CITY TOUR & KUANG SI WATERFALL [B/L/-]

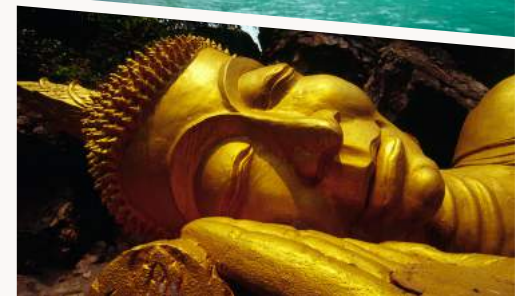
Your guide is flexible in when you prefer to start the tour. Start the tour by climbing up on the top of Phousi Mountain from where most parts of Luang Prabang are visible and it's worth the climb up the 328 steps to the top. There is a stupa and it offers a near 360 Degrees view of Luang Prabang. The Mountain is overlooking the former Royal Palace which is now the National Museum and our next stop. We follow the quiet back lanes to the beautiful historical Huan Chuan Heritage House, taking in its historical items and architectural charms while learning about the connection it has with the Royal Palace.

Near the top of the peninsula is Wat Xiengthong, the most famous temple in Luang Prabang, around 500 years old. It is easy to visit nearby temples such as Wat Mai as well if you like.

Our next stop is TAEC, (Traditional Arts & Ethnology Center), a place rich with information about Laos and its many diverse ethnicities. A great place to learn about the country and its people. For lunch you can select one of the many restaurant choices that Luang Prabang offers.

In the afternoon visit the stunning Kuang Si Waterfalls outside of Luang Prabang. Bring your swimwear if you want to dive into the crystal clear pools on the bottom of the falls. Explore the area and the Bear Rescue Center with the mission to free captive bears. Return to Luang Prabang.

### **DAY 3 | LUANG PRABANG -JOIN-IN MANDALAO ELEPHANT SANCTUARY THERAPEUTIC - SUNSET CRUISE [B/L/-]**

Arrive at MandaLao: Get an in-depth introduction into elephant behavior and communication.

Meet the Elephants: Guests cross the Nam Khan River by long tail boat for the first introduction to our elephants. MandaLao guides will introduce guests to our elephants and mahouts, providing background on our elephants. Guests will be provided bananas and/or sugar cane to feed the elephants.

Trek: Pass beautiful Lao gardens before exploring the jungle-covered Huay Nok stream. Guests walk with the elephants through the jungle as they interact with each other and forage on native foods. MandaLao guides continue to explain elephant behavior as they guide guests through the forest. The trek is 2.5 Km and takes about 1.5 hours, it is flat and shaded most of the way.

Say Goodbyes: After some final treats for the elephants, guests leave the elephants and mahouts in the jungle and begin the trek back to MandaLao with their guide.

Lunch: Enjoy traditional Lao cuisine made primarily from our own organic produce.

Arriving back your hotel for the rest of time at leisure.

In the late afternoon, you will be met for a short transfer to the Mekong Riverside where we board on private Sunset Cruise Take-in the panoramic views - oranges, reds, pinks, and purples of the changing sky as the sun sinks behind the mountains. Relax and enjoy the luxury cruise. Choice of Canape or Lao Tasting Platter or charcuterie board, a bottle of local beer, soft drinks or a bottle of red/white wine, all entrance fees and permissions. Return to town and transfer back to your hotel by early evening.

### **DAY 4 | LUANG PRABANG FLY TO VIENTIANE [B/-/-]**

Depending on your flight departure you may have free time at leisure before being transferred to the airport for your flight to Vientiane.

Upon arrival in Vientiane, greeting by your local guide, then transfer to hotel for your rest of time at leisure.

Vientiane is a quiet capital in Southeast Asia, It is a quaint and unassuming capital city hugging the Mekong River. The city's old world charm is mixed with its Chinese shop houses and French colonial architecture to create an intoxicating idyllic setting for your explorations of local historical sites.

## DAY 5 | VIENTIANE - CITY TOUR & BUDDHA PARK [B/-/-]

Today the pickup will be at 9 am.

First stop is Wat Sisaket, the only structure to survive the Siamese Invasion of 1828 intact. Across the street is Wat Ho Phra Kheo, which was rebuilt in the 1930's. It used to house the famous Emerald Buddha which is now on display in the Grand Palace in Bangkok.

You continue to Patuxai, a Lao Victory Monument, finished around 70 years ago. The monument was built using American funds and cement actually intended to build a new airport. The Royal Laotian Government instead built the monument, which earned it the nickname of the "vertical runway".

Next stop is That Luang – the most holy structure in all of Laos and prominently featured in many of Laos emblems. Also pay a visit to the COPE Visitor Center for an insight into the Secret War which left Laos the most heavily bombed country in history.

Lunch at Le Padaek restaurant.

In the afternoon take a ride outside of Vientiane to visit the famous Buddha Park close to the friendship bridge. On the way back stop at the Lao Disabled Women Development Center where women with disabilities come from all over Laos to live and study here, gaining life skills and vocational training to empower them to set up an independent life.

Return to Vientiane in the late afternoon.

Dinner at Khua Lao restaurant.

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## DAY 6 | VIENTIANE - DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Depending on your departure flight, you may have free time at leisure, before being met by your guide for a short transfer to the airport for your flight onward.

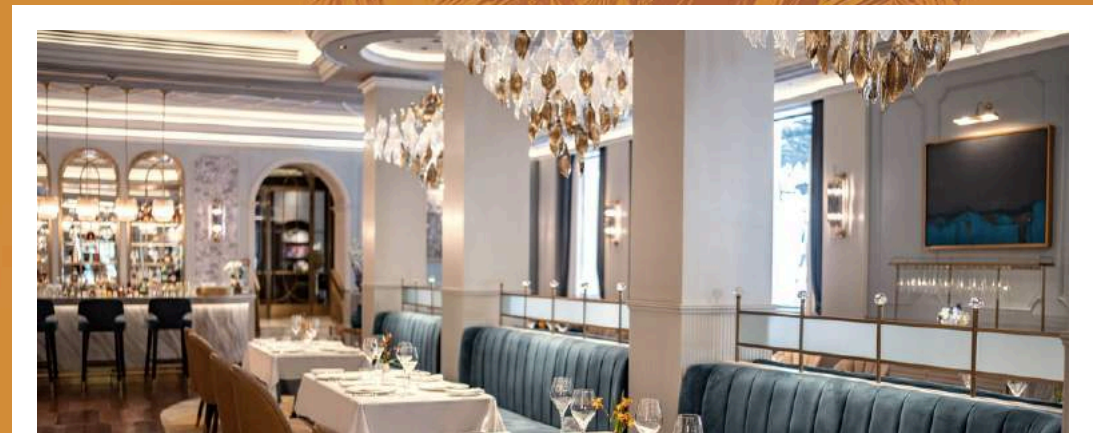
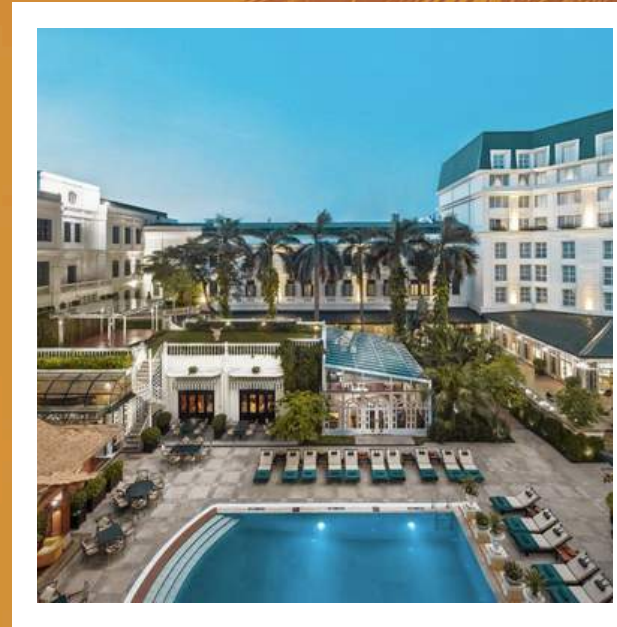

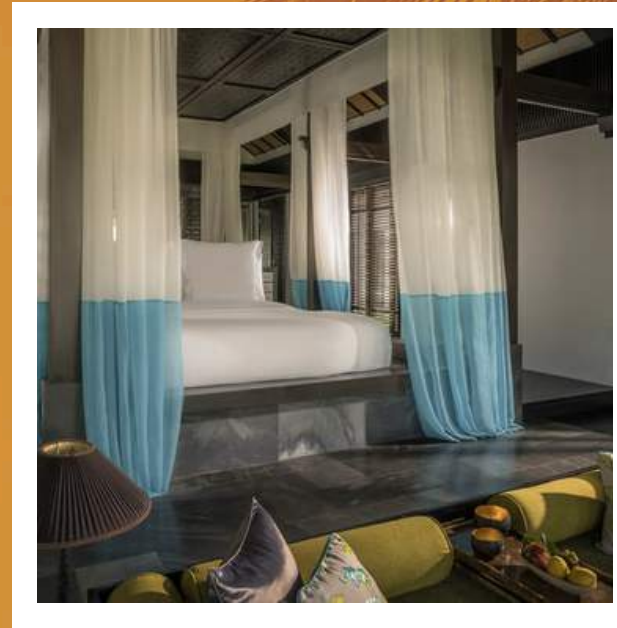

Xin chao! Welcome to Vietnam. Arrive in Hanoi and transfer to your hotel in Hanoi.

Kick off with a full-day walking tour of the city and explore Hanoi like a local! By the end of the day you will have a feel for this awesome city. In the evening, sit down to a traditional water puppet performance (or the 'Four Palaces' cultural show). This northern tradition, dating back nearly a thousand years, is performed alongside traditional Vietnamese music that employs drums, wooden bells, horns and bamboo flutes.

Explore nightlife in Hanoi at your leisure before evening departure on the overnight train to Lao Cai.

Depart from Sapa town, we will embark on a lovely walk to Lao chai and Ta van villages – Home to Black Hmong people. Some of the women shave their eyebrows because they believe a hairless face is beautiful. We will stop for lunch before leaving Giang Ta Chai and drive back to Sapa.
