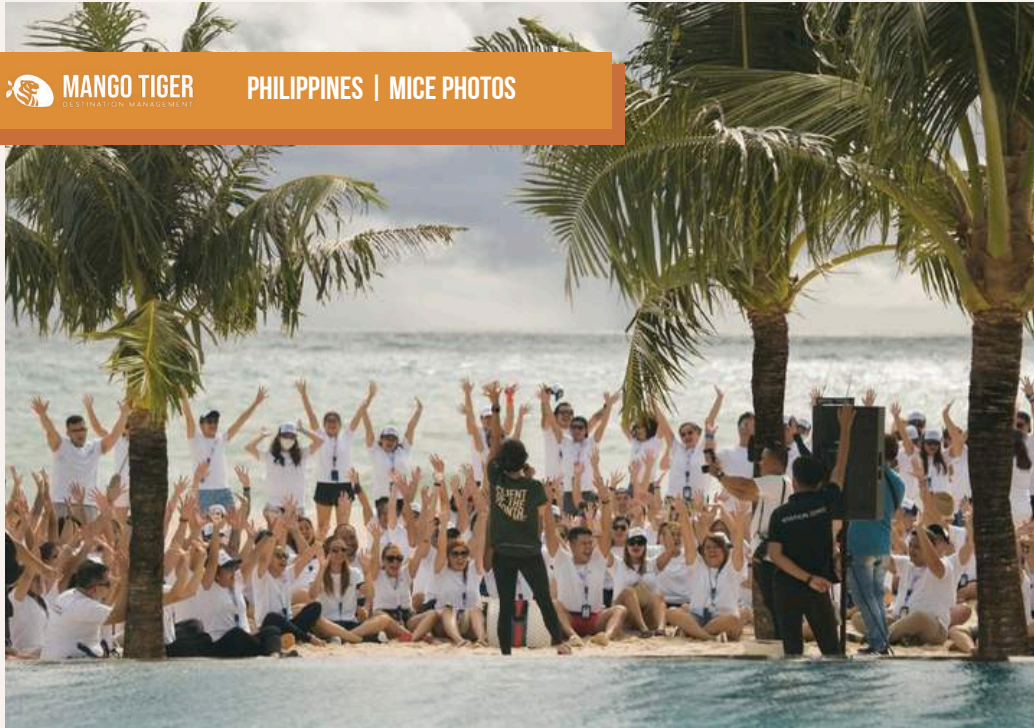

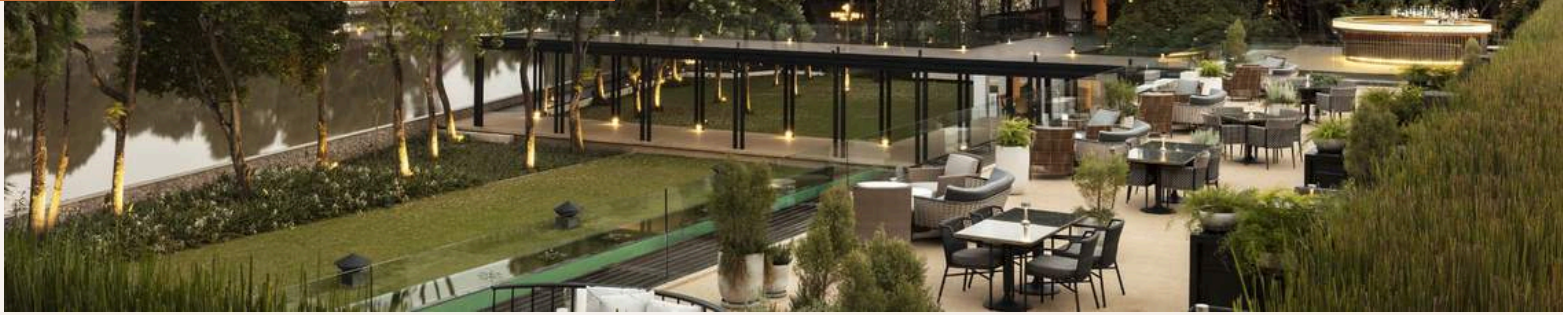

DAY 4 | CHIANG MAI – DOI SUTHEP, DOI PUI HMONG VILLAGE [B/L/D]

After breakfast it is time to explore the surroundings of Chiang Mai.

Doi Suthep is a mountain located about 15 kilometers northwest of Chiang Mai city center. At its summit sits Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, a revered Buddhist temple known for its golden chedi (stupa) and panoramic views of Chiang Mai.

The Naga staircase, the staircase leading up to Wat Phra That Doi Suthep is believed to be over 300 years old, dating back to the founding of the temple in 1383. However, the exact age of the staircase may vary depending on sources. In Thai culture, Nagas are revered as protectors and guardians, and their presence on the staircase symbolizes the spiritual journey to the temple and the protection offered to visitors.

Take time to observe Buddhist rituals and practices performed by visitors and monks alike. Remember to dress respectfully, covering your shoulders and knees, and remove your shoes before entering temple buildings.

Doi Pui Hmong Hill Tribe Village is a cultural and ethnic community located on Doi Pui mountain, just northwest of Chiang Mai city in Northern Thailand. The Hmong people are an ethnic minority group with a distinct culture and traditions. The village provides visitors with an opportunity to learn about Hmong culture, lifestyle, and craftsmanship.

Transfer back to your accommodation. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner at local restaurant serving traditional Northern Thai dishes.

DAY 5 | CHIANG MAI – THE BIKE FACTORY [B/L/D]

After a hearty breakfast The Bike Shop is waiting, a highly interactive team building activity where the group is tasked with a series of fun and energetic challenges, each earning them a piece of a bike. DAY 6 | CHIANG MAI – DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

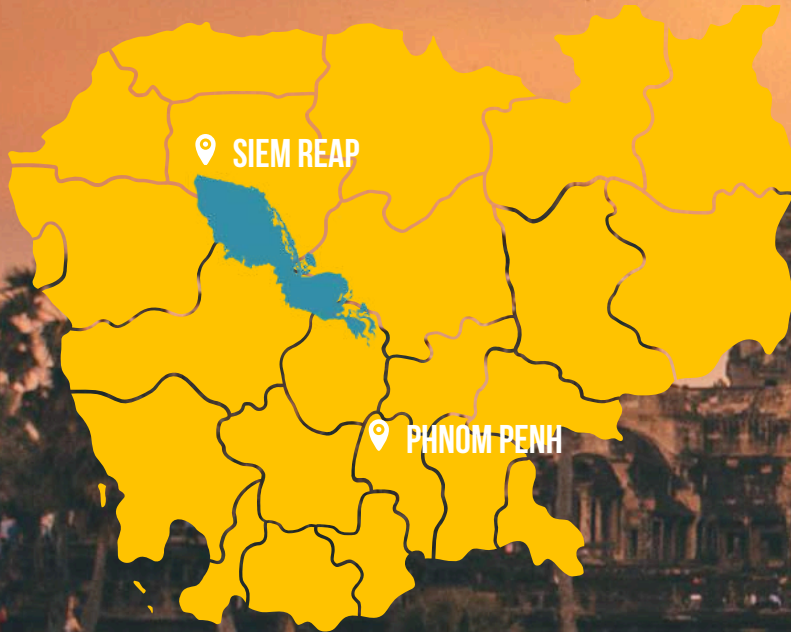

They depend on the faith and charity of the local people. After a bike ride just outside of Siem Reap, we will meet our village chef, who will take us grocery shopping at a local food market. You might learn to cook the popular dish Amok, a fish soup, or Samlor Korke, depending on the chef's recommendation. Once your Khmer meal is prepared, the chef and his wife will show you how to pack the food and some rice into a banana leaf. A short walk will take us to the pagoda where the monks live, allowing you to present the alms. The monk will likely give you a blessing, and you can ask him anything you wish to know about Cambodian culture and Buddhism. After offering the alms and enjoying lunch in a local Cambodian home, you will bike back to your hotel and relax for the afternoon.

Program 4: Host lunch in traditional stilt house on Tonle Sap

Your guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Siem Reap and take you on a journey to Kampong Khleang. As you travel, imagine the sight of wooden houses perched on 10-meter-tall stilts, surrounded by water during the wet season and nestled on the floodplains of the lake in the dry season. Along the dirt road to the village, you'll pass by numerous wooden houses and traditional fishing equipment, with local children waving and greeting you warmly. The community of Kampong Khleang is renowned for its inventive fishing techniques. You'll have the opportunity to learn about village life firsthand by visiting a local school, pagoda, witnessing the smoking of catfish, and chatting with a fisherman as he repairs his net. Your tour guide will share insightful stories about the village and how its residents sustain their daily lives. Later, indulge in a traditional Khmer lunch prepared by a local family. Delight in a variety of dishes that highlight the rich flavors of Cambodian cuisine. After lunch, embark on a boat ride on Tonle Sap Lake. Relax and savor some refreshing drinks as you take in the tranquil beauty of the floating village surroundings.

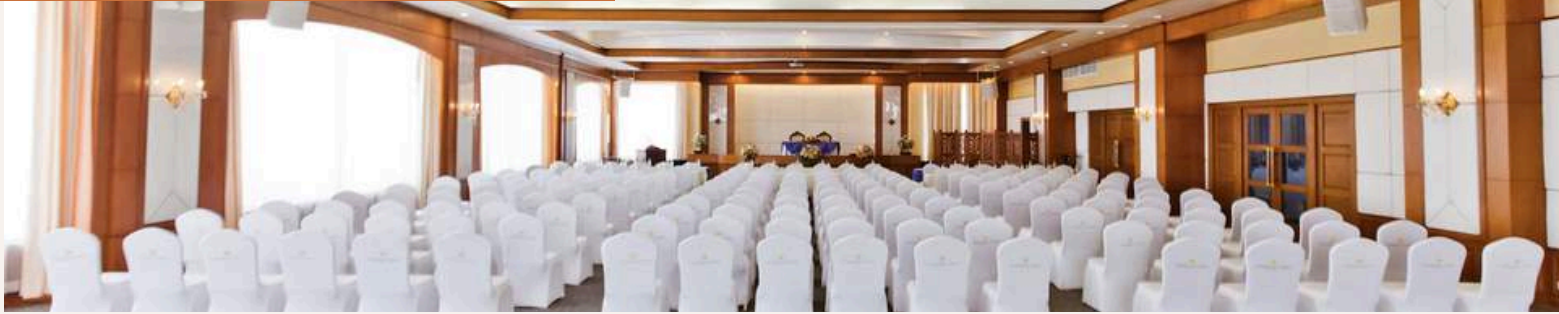

The final visit of the day will be the excellent COPE exhibition centre, highlighting a much overlooked aspect of Laos and a major problem many of the local people face on a day to day basis in the form of unexploded ordnance as a result of heavy bombing campaigns during the Vietnam War area. We then return to your hotel to freshen up.

Lunch is served at Kualao Restaurant.

In the afternoon we visit the quirky yet impressive Buddha Park, an enchanting collection of Buddhist and Hindu sculptures on the banks of the Mekong River. By no means historic – Buddha Park was built in the 1950's by a self styled 'holy man' – the park features some very photogenic and unusual sculptures, including a huge reclining Buddha, and a giant pumpkin. Upon returning to Vientiane we have the option of stopping at Mai Savanh Lao, and the Lao Disabled Womens Centre, which provides valuable training and schooling for disabled women in Laos. The women here are friendly, and its interesting to have a chat with them to find out about their lives.

In the evening dinner at a local Korean-Lao BBQ restaurant. *Overnight in Vientiane*

DAY 3 | VIENTIANE – LUANG PRABANG BY TRAIN - BACI [B/L/D]

Pick up time is depending on train ticket. Upon arriving in Luang Prabang you will be greeting by your driver, and then transfer to your hotel for some time to rest. You will meet in the early evening, for a short transfer to a nearby village where you have the opportunity to participate in a traditional Baci Ceremony. A Baci is performed in celebration of an important event such as weddings, births, or for welcoming guests and is a means of expressing good will and good luck to others. The ceremony is led by one of the village highly respected elderly and involves offerings to spirits and tying of strings to each other's wrists to lock in the good spirits.

DAY 4 | LUANG PRABANG [B/L/D]

An early bird you should not miss the alms giving ceremony that occurs every morning in the peaceful streets of Luang Prabang. Hundreds of monks flock out the many temples to collect alms from the locals. If you like, our guide can show you the best spots to enjoy this spectacle, we then walk to visit local fresh market to see how the locals shop. Back to hotel for breakfast.

After breakfast, we visit the quaint Royal Palace Museum that provides a fine overview of the culture and history of this ancient city. We follow the quiet back lanes to the beautiful historical Huan Chuan Heritage House, taking in its historical items and architectural charms while learning about the connection it has with the Royal Palace, we continue our walk up the peninsula to the country's most historic and enchanting temple, Wat Xiengthong. With its roof that sweeps low towards the ground, this temple & architecture best represents the classical Luang Prabang style. And then visit to the excellent 'Traditional Arts and Ethnology Centre', which gives a great insight into the rich and diverse ethnic and cultural blend of Laos.

The afternoon you visit the stunning Kuang Si Waterfalls outside of Luang Prabang. Bring your swimwear if you want to dive into the crystal clear pools on the bottom of the falls. Explore the different areas and the Bear Rescue Center with the mission to free captive bears. Return to Luang Prabang. On return to Luang Prabang you climb up Mount Phousi to enjoy the 360 degrees view over the UNESCO World Heritage town. *Overnight in Luang Prabang*

DAY 5 | LUANG PRABANG – PAK OU CRUISE & LAO TRIATHLON [B/L/D]

Transfer at 9:45 AM to the riverside for a fantastic cruise in a traditional Lao river boat that starts its cruise upstream the Mighty Mekong river, until we reach the famous Pak Ou Caves in the late morning. We then explore the spiritual caves, with has not less than 4,000 sacred Buddhist statues and images scattered around the two limestone caves. Nearby a picnic lunch on a riverbank is served.

We then board the boat and cruise gently downstream, We arrive back in Luang Prabang in the mid-afternoon. Transfer to your hotel to freshen up. In the late afternoon we meet and start the Lao Triathlon. Guests are separated in groups and each group is doing one activity at a time, then they will switch around. One station is a local Petanque Club where guests compete playing Petanque. 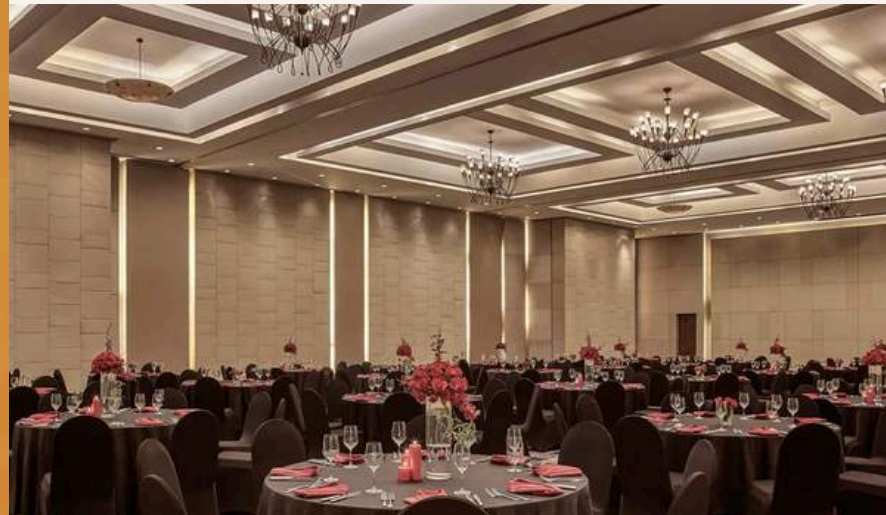
