Located through a small village, in the jungle of Bohol Island is located "The Frmcy." Living by the motto "let food and nature be thy medicine", this experience touches on all the local dishes you won't get anywhere else. All the food provided will be grown directly on site or from the neighboring villages, this will be the freshest Filipino foods you could get. This dining experience will touch on many different flavours through 8 courses of food alongside with fresh teas and juices provided.

As the most common mode of transportation in the Philippines being the Jeepney, you will **get a taste of how the locals travel**. Dating back to World War II, when the Americans pulled out of the Philippines leaving a massive surplus of jeeps here in the Philippines. The Filipinos creatively used all the leftover jeeps to create a rideshare system 100 years before Uber was created. Experience Palawan off the beaten track, including three different stops along the Lio Beach, Nacpan Beach, and Bulalacao Waterfalls.





Climb aboard a traditional MotoBanca and familiarize yourself with the smiling faces of our local crew who will guide you through the shallow waters and hidden coves for the next two days. Set sail through the turquoise waters, white sand beaches, and lush jungle foliage. Put on your fins and swim with the beautiful schools of colorful fish, vibrant coral reefs, sea turtles and – if you are lucky – eagle rays, whale sharks and dolphins. Manichan Garden House is a Lao-cuisine learning center and outdoor museum, created to teach Lao youth as well as foreign visitors about the Lao culture, knowing how the Lao ancestors had used their equipment in their daily life. There are a variety of different activities to participate with the main one being to learn about the cooking of the Son Phao Thai Daeng tribe (Red tribe), their traditional equipment, Lao Herbs and plants and traditional costumes.

The Lao Disabled Women's Development Center outside of Vientiane is a **non profit organization run by Lao women with disabilities**. It is offering training in income generating businesses as well as life skills and teaching the women about their civil rights. The center is offering various kinds of tours and activities as well as workshops and guided tours. Our customers have visited the center for many years, it's right on the way from or to the famous Buddha Park.





In the 4000 Islands take a boat trip with a local guide, who has lived his whole life along the Mekong River, stop at some of the Islands and **learn how to catch fish in the Mekong River**, there are many different technics to be shown, followed by a traditional Lao barbeque.



Deep in the east of Laos, deep in the forest, a remote place everybody should, but only a few really do visit, is the Nam Et Phou Louey National Park. Besides featuring an amazing Night Safari, also multiple trekking tours on which you spend your night in a Nest, in the middle of the jungle. Needless to say that the Ecotourism has helped massively in decreasing logging and hunting wildlife as the participating villages have now a different way to support their families.

One of the newest highlights in Laos is the Rock at Phou Par Marn. What was once a viewpoint is now a restaurant overviewing the limestones of Khammouane Province.

From here as a hub many different activities such as ziplining, spider-net, trekking, caving etc can be done while spending overnight in the one of the two trees houses or in one of the many Capsules.





The Xe Bang Fai cave is with a 6.4 km path through to be believed **one of the largest river caves in the world**, located in Hin Nam No National Park with passages some 120 meters tall and 200 meters wide. It on;ly came to attention in 2008 following a National Geographic expedition and is now partly accessible to visitors. It is not accessible all year round due to the rainy season and accommodation is available as camping or homestays.






